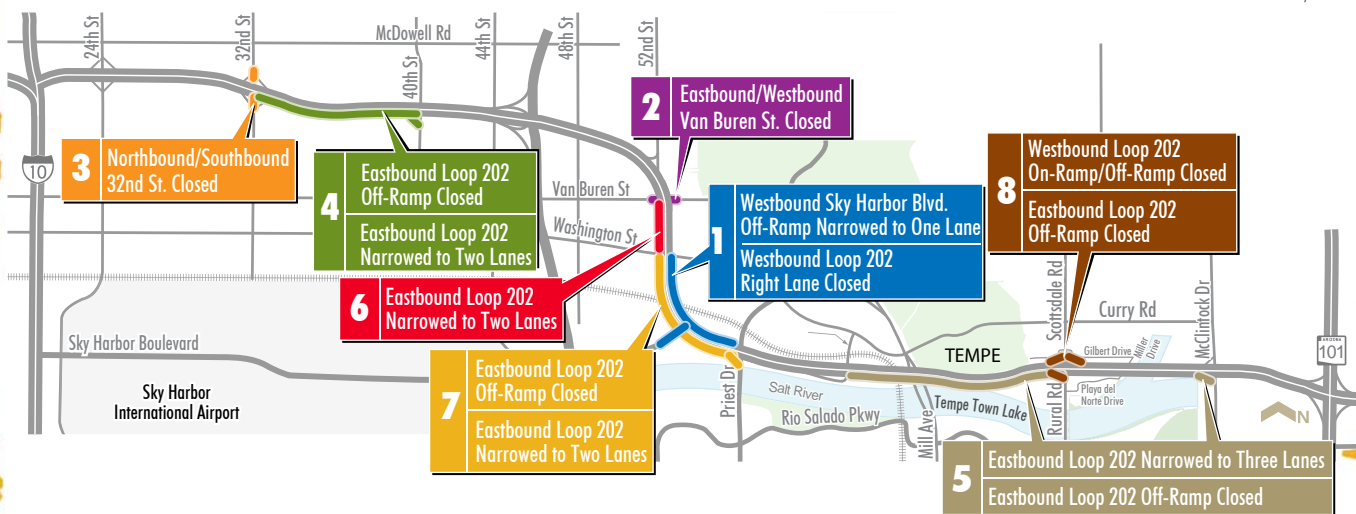


UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION-RELATED CLOSURES AND RESTRICTIONS

Nov. 6 - Nov. 9

- 1** **Westbound Sky Harbor Boulevard off-ramp narrowed to one lane. Westbound Loop 202 right lane closed between Priest Drive and Sky Harbor Boulevard.**
10 p.m. Friday (Nov. 6) – 7 a.m. Saturday (Nov. 7)
10 p.m. Saturday (Nov. 7) – 9 a.m. Sunday (Nov. 8)
- 2** **Van Buren Street closed in both directions under Loop 202. ***
Suggested Detour: Use Washington Street or McDowell Road
10 p.m. Friday (Nov. 6) – 5 a.m. Monday (Nov. 9)
- 3** **32nd Street closed in both directions under Loop 202. ***
Suggested Detour: Use 24th or 40th Streets
10 p.m. Friday (Nov. 6) – 7 a.m. Saturday (Nov. 7)
9 p.m. Sunday (Nov. 8) – 5 a.m. Monday (Nov. 9)
- 4** **Eastbound Loop 202 40th Street off-ramp closed. Eastbound Loop 202 narrowed to two lanes between 32nd and 40th Streets.**
Suggested Detour: Use 32nd Street off-ramp
10 p.m. Friday (Nov. 6) – 7 a.m. Saturday (Nov. 7)
10 p.m. Saturday (Nov. 7) – 9 a.m. Sunday (Nov. 8)
9 p.m. Sunday (Nov. 8) – 5 a.m. Monday (Nov. 9)
- 5** **Eastbound Loop 202 narrowed to three lanes between Center Parkway and Scottsdale Road. Eastbound Loop 202 McClintock Drive off-ramp closed.**
10 p.m. Friday (Nov. 6) – 7 a.m. Saturday (Nov. 7)
- 6** **Eastbound Loop 202 narrowed to two lanes between Van Buren Street and Washington Street**
10 p.m. Friday (Nov. 6) – 7 a.m. Saturday (Nov. 7)
- 7** **Eastbound Loop 202 Priest Drive off-ramp closed. Eastbound Loop 202 narrowed to two lanes between Washington Street and Priest Drive.**
Suggested Detour: Use 52nd Street
10 p.m. Saturday (Nov. 7) – 10 a.m. Sunday (Nov. 8)
- 8** **Westbound Loop 202 Scottsdale Road on-and off-ramps closed. Eastbound Loop 202 Scottsdale Road off-ramp closed.**
Suggested Detour for Westbound Loop 202: Use McClintock Drive on-ramp and Center Parkway off-ramp
Suggested Detour for Eastbound Loop 202: Use McClintock Drive off-ramp
9 p.m. Sunday (Nov. 8) – 5 a.m. Monday (Nov. 9)

*Please note: Access will be maintained to residences and businesses. Traffic will not be allowed to cross under Loop 202.



WORK ZONE SAFETY

Safety is a vital part of the ongoing construction process. It is important to plan ahead for restrictions and to slow down in the work zone. Drivers and pedestrians are responsible for staying alert and obeying traffic laws; including signage, traffic barricades and flaggers within construction work zones. **Most importantly: slow down in the work zones.**

As with any complex construction project, there is a possibility that severe weather or other unforeseen difficulties may result in unscheduled closures, restrictions, or delays.
