



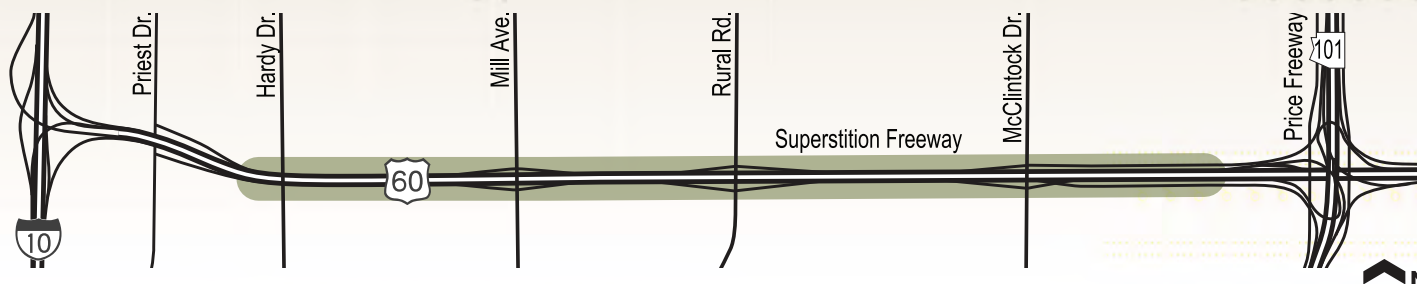
# US 60 Widening Project

## Superstition Freeway

### 60 PROJECT SUMMARY & FACTS

As part of Arizona Department of Transportation's (ADOT's) commitment to enhance the movement of people and products throughout Arizona, the US 60 Widening Project will add freeway capacity to improve mobility and reduce congestion on US 60 through the City of Tempe.

- Eastbound and westbound general purpose lanes will be added from west of Hardy Drive to east of McClintock Drive.
- Additional right-of-way will not be required to widen this corridor.
- Once completed, all ramp connections will remain in place.
- Existing sound walls will remain in place.
- Auxiliary lanes will be included to ease congestion and assist drivers with merging at on- and off-ramps.
- Quiet pavement (rubberized asphalt) will be placed to reduce noise.



### 60 PROJECT SCHEDULE

- **November 1 & 2, 2008** - Construction will begin
- **Late 2009** - Completion is expected

### 60 WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Outreach to adjacent residents and businesses will continue throughout the project.
- Construction will require restrictions to freeway lanes, on- and off-ramps, as well as additional impacts on city streets. The project team will provide regular updates to the surrounding community.
