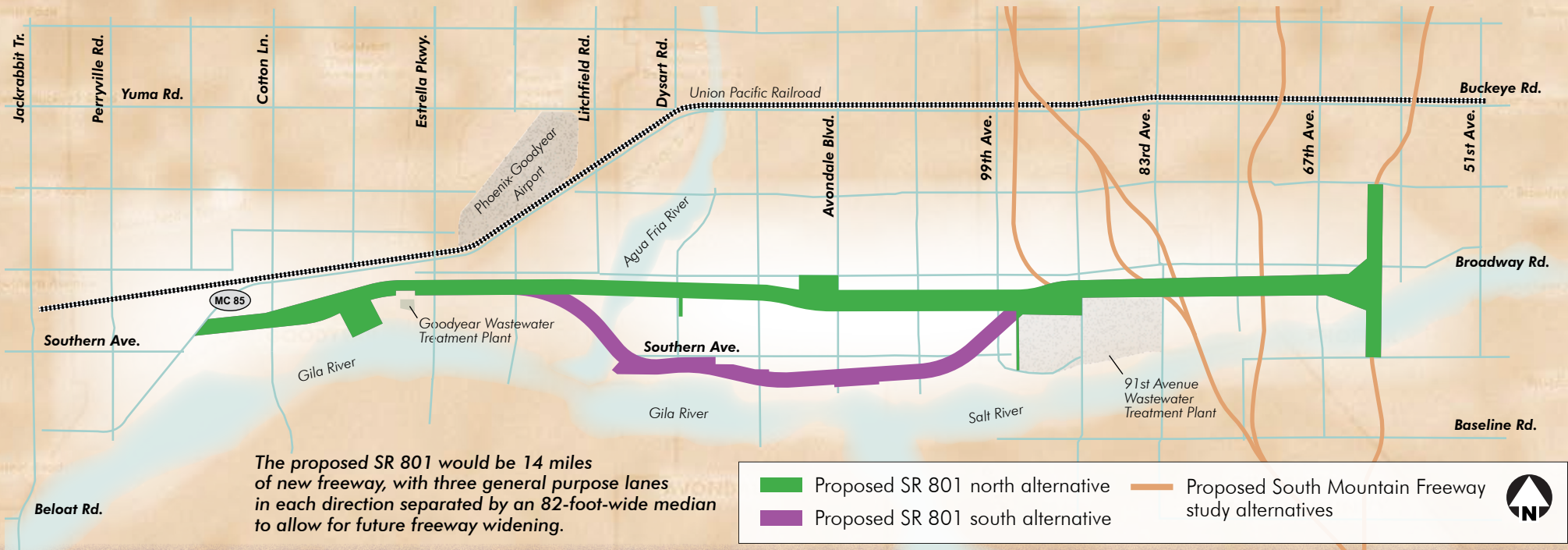


State Route 801

Proposed Loop 303 to Proposed Loop 202



Project Update

The Arizona Department of Transportation, in conjunction with the Federal Highway Administration, is studying a proposed east-west freeway in western Maricopa County. Since fall 2006, the study team has refined the three corridors for State Route 801 that were previously presented. The map above displays the alternatives currently under consideration.

State Route 801 would provide another east-west route to help relieve congestion on Interstate 10. This freeway is another element of the Regional Transportation Plan associated with the passage of Proposition 400 in November 2004.

State Route 801 would begin at SR 85 and connect at the proposed Loop 202 (South Mountain Freeway). The project is being studied in two phases, SR 801 East and West. State Route 801 East includes the area between the proposed Loop 303 and Loop 202 freeways. State Route 801 West includes the area between SR 85 and the proposed Loop 303.

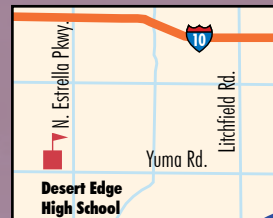
