

# State Route 95 Widening Project at Holiday Harbour



## Project Overview

The SR 95 widening project at Holiday Harbour includes the construction of a continuous two-way left turn lane and drainage improvements just south of Parker Dam.

The project will cover less than a mile and enhance access and safety for motorists.

The residents of Holiday Harbour and motorists passing through the area can look forward to:

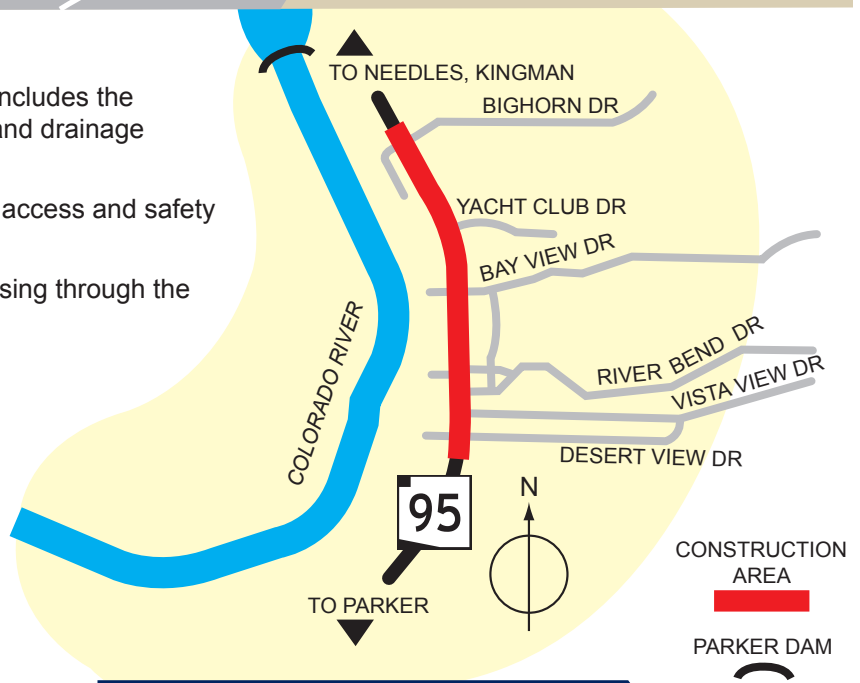
- Widening of an existing two-lane highway
- Addition of a continuous two-way left-turn lane
- Removal and replacement of existing pavement
- Drainage improvements
- New lighting, signage and markings
- Installation of a water/sewer line

## Construction Update

Traffic is expected to be impacted Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Speed limit will be reduced to 25 mph. Workers will be present to direct traffic. Law enforcement will be present to monitor speeds. Work begins November 15, 2010 and is expected to end summer 2011.

The Arizona Department of Transportation will provide updates and alerts as information about additional impacts to traffic becomes available.

ADOT works to inform the public about planned highway restrictions, but there is a possibility that unscheduled closures or restrictions may occur. Weather can also affect a project schedule.



## Slow down in the work zone

As always, drivers are reminded to proceed through the work zone with caution, slow down, and be alert for construction equipment and personnel.
